
Lubavitch of Wisconsin, located at 3109 N. Lake Drive, Milwaukee, WI 53012, is considering purchasing both the Greensquare I and Greensquare II buildings located at 6789-91 N. Green Tree Road. The Greensquare II building is 7560 gross square feet and is a single story structure. Currently, there are three tenants in the Greensquare II building, two are used for office space, and one is an exercise facility.

There would be a proposed change of use for the Greensquare II building. The primary use of the facility would be for a small school for high school age girls. Lubavitch of Wisconsin operates an LLC called Hillel High School. HHS is a wraparound program for high school age students to enable them to use external on-line school products in a controlled environment with facilitators available to help guide their learning. In addition, through partnerships with other high schools they are able to offer credits for Judaic students which can be applied towards a high school diploma. They have separate divisions for boys and girls. They are looking to have the girls division use the facility for the 2017-18 school year. This space would consist of both individual learning areas where students will each work with their on-line classes, then study the general subjects where the facilitators and Judaic teachers will instruct. By the 2017-18 school year it is anticipated there will be 20 students with a minimum of 2 teachers. During the next 4-5 years enrollment could increase to a maximum of 50 students, with 5 teachers. The school hours of operation will be Monday through Friday, 8AM to 4PM. The school will always be single gender.

They are anticipating some time in the future the prospect of a secondary use of the facility for the purposes of religious services. The synagogue would hold services on Saturday from 9AM to 2PM, which includes time for communal gathering and a meal after the service. There would also be a service on Sunday morning from 8AM to 9:30AM. Initially, there would be 40-60 members with the ability to grow to 100 members. Many of the families attending are from the neighborhood and walk to the services. All modifications to the Greensquare II building would be limited to interior remodeling. There are no proposed exterior changes other than new signage which will fit the general aesthetics of the facility. Interior demolition could begin in January 2017 after existing tenant leases expire, possibly sooner as tenants vacate the building.


In addition to the proposed changes to the Greensquare II building Lubavitch of Wisconsin would be moving administrative offices into the lower level of the Greensquare I building. No physical changes would be necessary for this move. The tenants on the ground floor and second floor of the Greensquare I building would remain as is. As the office needs of Lubavitch of Wisconsin grow, they may expand into other office space as tenants vacate. There are no other current plans for the Greensquare I building.

The site has a total of 97 parking spaces, 4 of which are ADA accessible. No changes are anticipated to the parking layout. The number of existing parking spaces provided exceeds the number required for the proposed changes of use to the Greensquare II building per the Glendale Zoning Code, Article G, Chapter 13.1.92 (g).




They may not be perfect memories; I have had my ups and downs over the years, but I am proud to have collaborated with so many to improve local government within the three communities I have served -- teamwork, which I fear, is becoming more rare in Wisconsin and in our own community.

I can not help but think of the people -- sadly, many of who are no longer with us -- that have made my 44 year career in Wisconsin local government possible, and who have contributed so much and who have molded me into the person I am today.

In government, as in the business world, a group or team effort is necessary in order to succeed. One of the most valuable lessons I have learned is that collaborative governance is the path to success. I have grown to recognize and accept the fact that the solution to a problem does not always conform to my initial vision.

I could not have accomplished anything without the support, cooperation and assistance of innumerable elected and appointed officials, a professional support staff, consultants, attorneys, financial advisors, civil engineers, architects, developers, and most importantly, the citizens of Glendale. Any recognition I have received over the years is a recognition of the achievements of these people that I have had the pleasure to collaborate with.

As I pass the torch to a new generation, my only wish is that those who are just beginning their careers in local government, as well as, those in my profession, are as lucky as I have been over these past 44 years. ## MEMORANDUM

**RE:** Continued Employment During Transition/Succession

**DATE:** June 29, 2016

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The undersigned currently serve the City in the positions noted above. Based upon age and years of service, it is anticipated that Ms. DiFrances and Mr. Stuebe would likely retire in four to six years. Mr. Eastman is currently age 60, but would continue into the foreseeable future to accommodate an orderly transition to a successor City Administrator.

In order to achieve both the goal of assuring an optimal transition for the City, while also preserving our interest in continued employment within the Wisconsin Retirement System, an employment contract is submitted for your review and consideration. We are seeking your approval, as we feel it is in our mutual interests.

The contract on its face does not concern itself with existent or future salaries, nor modifications of employment policies. It covers only two aspects of our employment, which is specified within the four corners of the document. The conditions of employment covered are merely that if we commit to the City, the City commits to us. Our proposed employment terms would allow for removal for cause as that term is used in the Wisconsin Statutes. In addition, the highest retirement benefit package existent during the course of our employment would be preserved without retroactive diminution.

Again, thank you for your consideration.

## **PARTIAL EMPLOYMENT AGREEMENT**

This Agreement is made by and between the City of Glendale, hereinafter Employer, and David Eastman, hereinafter Employee, effective the last date of execution by the parties.

WHEREAS, David Eastman is currently serving in the employ of the City of Glendale in the capacity of Director of City Services, and

WHEREAS, Employee wishes to continue in such capacity until March 31, 2018, the period from date of execution of this Agreement to the afore described end date being defined as the term of Employee's employment, and

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Glendale, Employer, has determined that it is in the public interest that Employee so serve, and desires to discourage Employee from seeking alternate employment during the afore described term.

NOW, THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY specifically agreed by and between the parties, for the mutual consideration of the benefit to each party, as follows:

1. Employee agrees to continue employment with Employer through the term as set forth above.
2. ### Members of the Council

Despite what one alderman might have expressed, city ordinances do NOT outline a procedure for the filling of the City Administrator position. I reviewed the city ordinances before developing a proposed process. I then discussed all of the details of the process with Mr. Maslowski and he approved my proposed process before I sent it out. He praised the idea of a public listening session before we start as a way to further engage residents and work to build a stronger community.

The entirety of the city ordinance regarding the hiring of a City Administrator or other city officer is pasted here:

2.3.2 (c) Vacancies. (1) At such time that any City office listed in Subsection (a) above becomes vacant, the Common Council, or the City Administrator at the direction of the Common Council, shall take the necessary steps to advertise the vacant position. In selecting persons qualified to assume any of the aforesaid respective offices, consideration shall be given to basic qualifications, including background, both as to education and experience, as well as knowledge of the various subject matters involved, personal ability and qualifications, and general disposition towards the particular office.

THERE IS NO PROCESS OUTLINED, other than to say that the Council is responsible for advertising the position. The process for reviewing applications, interviewing candidates and narrowing down the selection pool is entirely at the discretion of the Common Council. The duties of the City Administrator are outlined in detail here: <http://glendale-wi.org/DocumentCenter/Home/View/64>, beginning on page 20 at 2.3.3. Once again, there is no defined process in the ordinance for filling that position.

We DO HAVE a more detailed hiring process for the City Attorney. It is the ONLY city position that has a hiring process outlined in the ordinance. I borrowed from it when I made the recommendation for how to proceed with hiring a new City Administrator. My proposing two aldermen and the mayor as members of the review committee was not accidental. It follows the process for hiring the City Attorney. Lacking a City Administrator to serve on his/her own search committee, I proposed asking neighboring villages if we could have the assistance of their Village Administrators. Additionally, I proposed adding the Director of City Services and the City Attorney, in order to put more voices on the committee.

I am pasting the ordinance that contains the hiring process for the City Attorney here:

2.3.7 The City of Glendale elects, pursuant to the provisions of Sec. 62.09(3)(b)(3) of the Wisconsin Statutes, that the method of selection of the City Attorney shall be by appointment by two-thirds (2/3) of the members-elect of the Common Council, under the system of selection set forth as follows:

(a) All eligible and qualified applicants will be required to submit a full account of their respective training and experience with a suitable letter of application, together with a comprehensive resume, at least three (3) references [of which only one (1) may be from the same law firm, if applicable], and several writing samples(i.e., opinions, position statements, briefs, etc.).

(b) A special review committee comprised of the Mayor, the City Administrator and two (2) Aldermen will screen the applications, check the references, conduct informal interviews and narrow the field to a selected number. Those applications so selected by the special review committee will be forwarded to the Common Council for further review.

(c) The Mayor and the Common Council, together with the City Administrator, will review the applications forwarded to them by the special review committee, conduct interviews, seek additional information and narrow the selection field to two (2) candidates. The candidates' applications will be forwarded to the Mayor for his selection and formal appointment.

What I proposed as a possible process for selecting a new City Administrator is pretty much in line with what is outlined in the city ordinance above for selecting the City Attorney. I proposed adding a few more people on the review committee. I also proposed having a public listening session to gauge public opinion on what qualities and skill set residents would like to see in the next City Administrator. Not having hired for the position in almost 37 years, I felt that residents might want to be involved to a limited degree. This would happen BEFORE we post the position description and begin accepting resumes. Community leaders, stakeholders, and the general public can provide us with their thoughts and input to help shape our decision-making process before we begin our search.

For six administrations and various permutations of the Common Council the input and counsel of staff, particularly Dick and I, was sought and considered. I offer these comments in the interest of the City, though there was certainly and admittedly no input solicited.

The preface of the Mayor's suggestion includes much political appeal such as "community voices," "open and transparent," and "stakeholder input." The process has always been open and public, but never designed by those whose business is primarily unacquainted, or even disassociated, from the function of the administrator. The sheer number is unwieldy and thus inherently an impediment.

Step two after the initial process excludes the majority of the Council, the very persons elected to effectuate this transition. Step three leaves that body a predetermined list quite possibly minus a candidate which would have been deemed appropriate by that majority.

Members of the Common Council:

Last night, I was just as surprised as you were with the Richard's announcement of his retirement in two months. While Richard and I had talked a number of times since his lengthy illness this past Spring about process, no timetable for his announcement was ever discussed or established. We had merely looked at how best to incorporate many community voices when the time came to look for a new City Administrator. I told Richard a number of times that when he was ready to give us notice, I would lead the council through the search and hiring process. It was entirely his decision.

After Richard's announcement last night, I asked to meet with him this morning to go over the best possible process that incorporates public, staff and stakeholder input. What I am outlining here was discussed with Richard, and he agreed that this process is open, transparent and involves a large number of individuals that interact with the City Administrator.

I am proposing the following process for the search, screening, interviewing and hiring of the next City Administrator:

1. Open meeting during the week of July 11 to gather input from many stakeholders. We will extend invitations to community and business leaders. These are individuals that come to mind: Carl Mueller of Mueller Communications, Chamber of Commerce President Dale Schmidt, M.P. Thierault of Bayshore, Brian Cramer from the Orthopedic Hospital, Jeff Hamilton from Sprecher's, Jenna Kunde from Johnson Controls who also serves as Chair of the 4th of July Comm, County Board Chair Theo Lipscomb, Nicolet Superintendent Dr. Kobylski, Nicolet School Board members, Glendale-River Hills Superintendent Larry Smalley, GDRH School Board members, Dave Eastman, Todd Stuebbe, Collin Johnson, Police Chief Tom Czarnyska, Fire Chief Robert Whitaker, members of the Plan Commission, members of the Community Development Authority, the City Attorney, members of the Common Council. I am certain that you all will think of others. Please let me know so I can invite them. The purpose of this meeting

is to receive input from the community. It allows community leaders and stakeholders to see that their voices are being heard and that they have input in this process.

2. Posting of the position description and announcement for 30 days.

3. Formation of the review committee. The committee will be: Mayor, two alderpersons chosen by the mayor and approved by the council, two local Village Administrators that will be invited by the Mayor (Peterson from Bayside and Schwarz from Shorewood are the ones I think would help us best address North Shore intergovernmental cooperation), City Services Dave Eastman, Police Chief Czarnyska, City Attorney John Fuchs. This committee will interview 8-12 people and narrow down the list to 3-4 finalists.

4. Common council interviews the finalists and then approves a ranking. Offer is extended to the first choice candidate. If that individual declines, the offer is made to the second choice, etc...
