Meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Ald. JoAnn Shaw.

ADOPTION OF MINUTES.

Motion was made by Ald. Vukovic, seconded by Ald. Wiese to approve the minutes of the meeting held on March 23, 2020. Ayes: Ald. Shaw, Vukovic, and Wiese. Noes: None. Abstain: None. Absent: None. Motion carried.

REVIEW AND CONSIDERATION OF 2020 RENEWAL ALCOHOL BEVERAGE LICENSE APPLICATIONS.

City Administrator Rachel Safstrom explained that the State of Wisconsin requires all Alcohol Beverage Licenses be renewed every year on July 1. All licenses before the Committee have been approved for location, and all background checks have been concluded by the City of Glendale Police Department.

The Legislative, Judiciary & Finance Committee considered the applications for all Renewal Alcohol Beverage retail licenses for the July 1, 2020 to June 30, 2021 license period. Administrator Safstrom stated both Pick n Save locations and Buffalo Wild Wings have had no notable issues since the issuing of licenses for 2019-2020. Ald. Wiese raised concern over the video camera surveillance systems at the Pick n Save locations, and their effectiveness based on camera placement. Administrator Safstrom will request the Police Department conduct a review of the surveillance system to ensure functionality.

Motion was made by Ald. Wiese, seconded by Ald. Shaw recommend the Common Council approve the 2020 Renewal Alcohol Beverage Licenses applications.

BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS:

The State of Wisconsin requires any business selling alcohol to have an Alcohol Beverage License. All other licenses have been approved for the current location and all background checks have been concluded by the City of Glendale Police Department.

- Class “B” (beer) retailers may sell beer to consumers for on-premises or off-premises consumption. (sec. 125.26(1), (2), (3), (4), and (5))
- “Class C” (wine) retailers may sell wine by the glass or in an opened original container for consumption on the premises where sold. Such licenses may only be issued for restaurants if the sale of alcohol beverages accounts for less than 50% of the gross receipts. It may not be issued to foreign corporations or foreign LLC's. (sec. 125.51(3m))

La Barbue LLC, DBA Mallrat, meets all the statutory requirements to be issued a Class “B” and “Class C” license. Proposed agent, N. Davaur, was approved by the Police Department.

RECOMMENDATION:

All applications are on file in the Clerk’s office. The appropriate background checks were completed by the Police Department.

Staff recommends approval of the Class “B” (beer) Retailer License, and “Class C” (wine) Retailer License.
