

CITY OF GLENDALE -- COMMON COUNCIL  
January 11, 2016

Regular meeting of the Common Council of the City of Glendale held in the Municipal Building, 5909 North Milwaukee River Parkway.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Bryan Kennedy at 6:00 p.m.

Request from Lakeshore Veterinary Clinic, 2100 West Silver Spring Drive, for temporary use of City property and an ordinance creating Section 10-1-43 of the Code pertaining to Resident Only Parking.

As discussed at the December 14, 2015 Common Council meeting, Lakeshore Veterinary Clinic, 2100 West Silver Spring Drive, is in the process of expanding their facility. This expansion project has increased the problems of street parking in the immediate neighborhood. Problems have existed for several years due to the parking of vehicles from Enterprise Rental and from Heiser Ford. The current construction at Lakeshore has increased the parking problems for area residents. The Police Chief, working with the City Attorney, has drafted an ordinance limiting parking to only residents. Recently, Lakeshore requested use of the city right of way, (formally used as an alley) off of Crestwood Blvd. for construction trailers. This twenty foot wide right of way has been landscaped and maintained by the City as a buffer between the commercial and residential uses, Lakeshore has indicated that residents living in the home to the north do not object – they are employees of the clinic. The draft ordinance and the request from Lakeshore Veterinary Clinic were discussed by the Public Safety/Public Works Committee.

Based upon the recommendation of the Public Safety/Public Works Committee, motion was made by Ald. Shaw, seconded by Ald. Gelhard, to grant the request from Lakeside Animal Clinic, 2100 W. Silver Spring Dr, to temporarily use City property subject to the owners of the Clinic signing a lease agreement, to be prepared by the City Attorney, providing full restoration of the site to City satisfaction and holding the City harmless from any liability or responsibility during the use of the property.

The ordinance creating Section 10-1-43 of the Code pertaining to Resident Only Parking was laid over to July in order to determine the parking impact on the neighborhood once construction of the Clinic is completed and Enterprise Rent a Car relocates. Ayes: Ald. Sweeney, Gelhard, Wiese, Goldberg and Shaw. Noes: None. Absent: Ald. Whitaker. Motion carried unanimously.
