Project Overview

The City of Glendale, in cooperation with the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT), is considering an undertaking located at five (5) intersections along Silver Spring Drive. Below is a list of the locations and safety improvement measures specific to each location. **The purpose of this project is to improve pedestrian and vehicular safety.**

Proposed Improvements

Location #1 Silver Spring Drive/N. Long Island Drive Intersection:

Improvements planned include roadway pavement marking & signing, installation of curb ramps and pedestrian activated Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacon signs (RRFB). Safety will be enhanced by warning motorists of pedestrian crossings through RRFBs. Additional pedestrian safety measures will include high visibility crosswalks and ADA compliant curb ramps.

Location #2 Silver Spring Drive/Pick n' Save Driveway: Improvements planned include roadway pavement marking & signing, installation of curb ramps, overhead traffic signal devices, pedestrian countdown timers and replacement of deteriorated crosswalks and concrete pavement. These improvements will enhance vehicular safety by placing signal indications over the eastbound and westbound lanes of traffic. Pedestrian safety will be enhanced with high visibility cross walks, ADA compliant curb ramps and pedestrian countdown signal indications.

Location #3 Silver Spring Drive/N. Bridgewood Lane Intersection: Improvements planned include roadway pavement marking & signing, installation of curb ramps, overhead traffic signal devices, pedestrian countdown timers and replacement of decorative crosswalks and concrete pavement. Safety will be enhanced for pedestrians and motorists through the installation of these measures.

Location #4 Silver Spring Drive/N. Bayshore Drive/N Mohawk Avenue Intersection: Improvements planned include roadway pavement marking & signing, installation of curb ramps, intersection lighting, overhead traffic signal devices, pedestrian countdown timers and replacement of decorative crosswalks and concrete pavement. Safety will be enhanced for pedestrians and motorists through the installation of these measures.

Location #5: Silver Spring Drive/N. Lydell Avenue Intersection: Improvements planned include roadway pavement marking & signing, installation of curb ramps, intersection lighting, pedestrian countdown timers and full replacement of traffic signal devices. Safety will be enhanced for pedestrians and motorists through the installation of these measures.

All locations will include temporary traffic control during construction. It is anticipated that Temporary Limited Easements (TLE) will be needed at six (6) properties for curb ramp installations.

Project costs for design and construction have been made possible through a federally funded, WisDOT Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) grant. WisDOT administers HSIP Projects under a 90% federal and 10% local cost sharing agreement.

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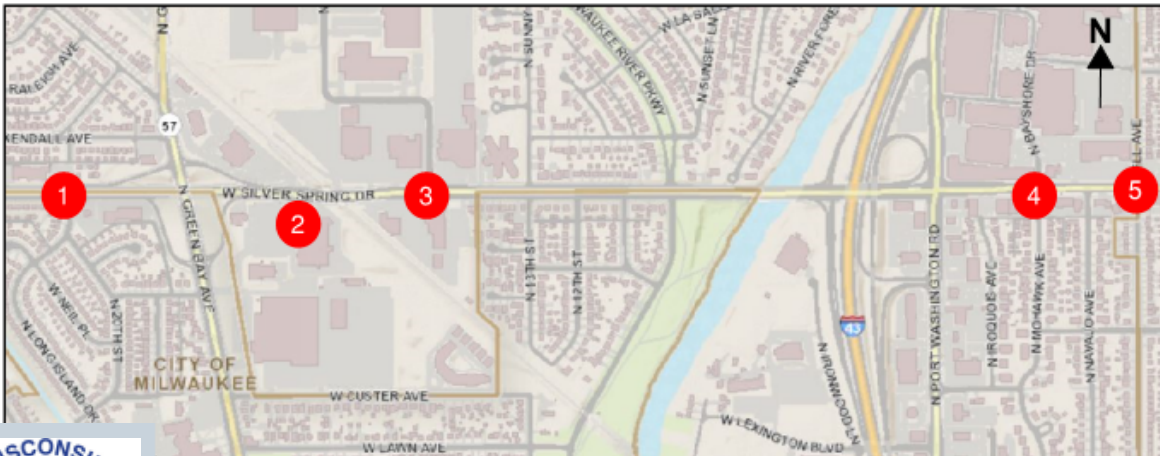
