ADOPTION OF MINUTES.

REVIEW AND CONSIDERATION OF 2021 RENEWAL ALCOHOL BEVERAGE LICENSE APPLICATIONS.

City Administrator Rachel Safstrom explained the State of Wisconsin requires all Alcohol Beverage Licenses be renewed every year on July 1. All licenses before the Committee have been approved for location, and all background checks have been concluded by the City of Glendale Police Department. There are several entities with unabated issues with the North Shore Fire Department (NSFD). If the issues are not corrected by midnight on June 30, 2021, the business will not be allowed to sell alcohol and the Glendale Police Department will enforce this restriction.

Ald. Shaw raised the question regarding what would happen in the event that Pick 'n Save does not abate their issues and currently stocks liquor in the main section of their store. Administrator Safstrom clarified the store would be required to take the alcohol off the premises if they are not able to close off the section and lock it up.

Motion was made by Ald. Wiese, seconded by Ald. Vukovic, to recommend the Common Council approve the 2021 Renewal Alcohol Beverage Licenses applications, contingent on all outstanding NSFD issues being abated by June 30, 2021. Ayes: Ald. BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS:

The State of Wisconsin requires any business selling alcohol to have an Alcohol Beverage License. Target Corporation – Target Store T-2877 is requesting a Class “A” license, for beer and liquor to be sold in the original package for off-premises consumption only. The premise description includes online order pickup at dedicated guest parking stalls in the front of the lot, including pathways utilized for access to the stalls.

All other licenses have been approved for the current location and all background checks have been concluded by the City of Glendale Police Department.

Target Corporation – Target Store T-2877, meets all statutory requirements to be issued Class “A” beer and liquor licenses. Proposed agent, N. Sotiros, was approved by the Police Department.

RECOMMENDATION:

All applications are on file in the Clerk’s office. The appropriate background checks were completed by the Police Department.

Staff recommends approval of Alcohol Beverage Retailer License.
